
Alpena Flyer



A Brief History

The Alpena Motor Car Company built the Alpena Flyer from 1910 until 1914. The car was light and inexpensive. It was durable and reliable that handled well in all types of weather and road conditions. It took anywhere from a few weeks to two months to build a Flyer. The Alpena Flyer got its

name because horses and buggies were common at the time, so automobiles seemed to fly down the roads. This car cost \$1,450 in 1910. In comparison the Model T. Ford cost \$900.
