Common Fossils in Northeast Michigan

Brachiopod: brachiopods shelled marine creatures that have a very long history of life on Earth.

Coral: coral reefs are made up of tiny, soft-bodied organisms called coral polyps.

Petoskey Stones: these stones are fossilized hexagonaria which is a type of coral. The Petoskey Stone is Michigan's State Stone.

Favocite: this is another type of coral.

Crinoid: crinoids are marine animals with branching arms.

Trilobite: trilobites are one of the oldest animals that first lived on the Early. They became extinct about 250 million years ago.
