## Common Fossils in Northeast Michigan

**Brachiopod:** brachiopods shelled marine creatures that have a very long history of life on Earth.

**Coral:** coral reefs are made up of tiny, softbodied organisms called coral polyps.

**Petoskey Stones:** these stones are fossilized hexagonaria which is a type of coral. The Petoskey Stone is Michigan's State Stone.

Favocite: this is another type of coral.

**Crinoid:** crinoids are marine animals with branching arms.

**Trilobite:** trilobites are one of the oldest animals that first lived on the Early. They became extinct about 250 million years ago.
