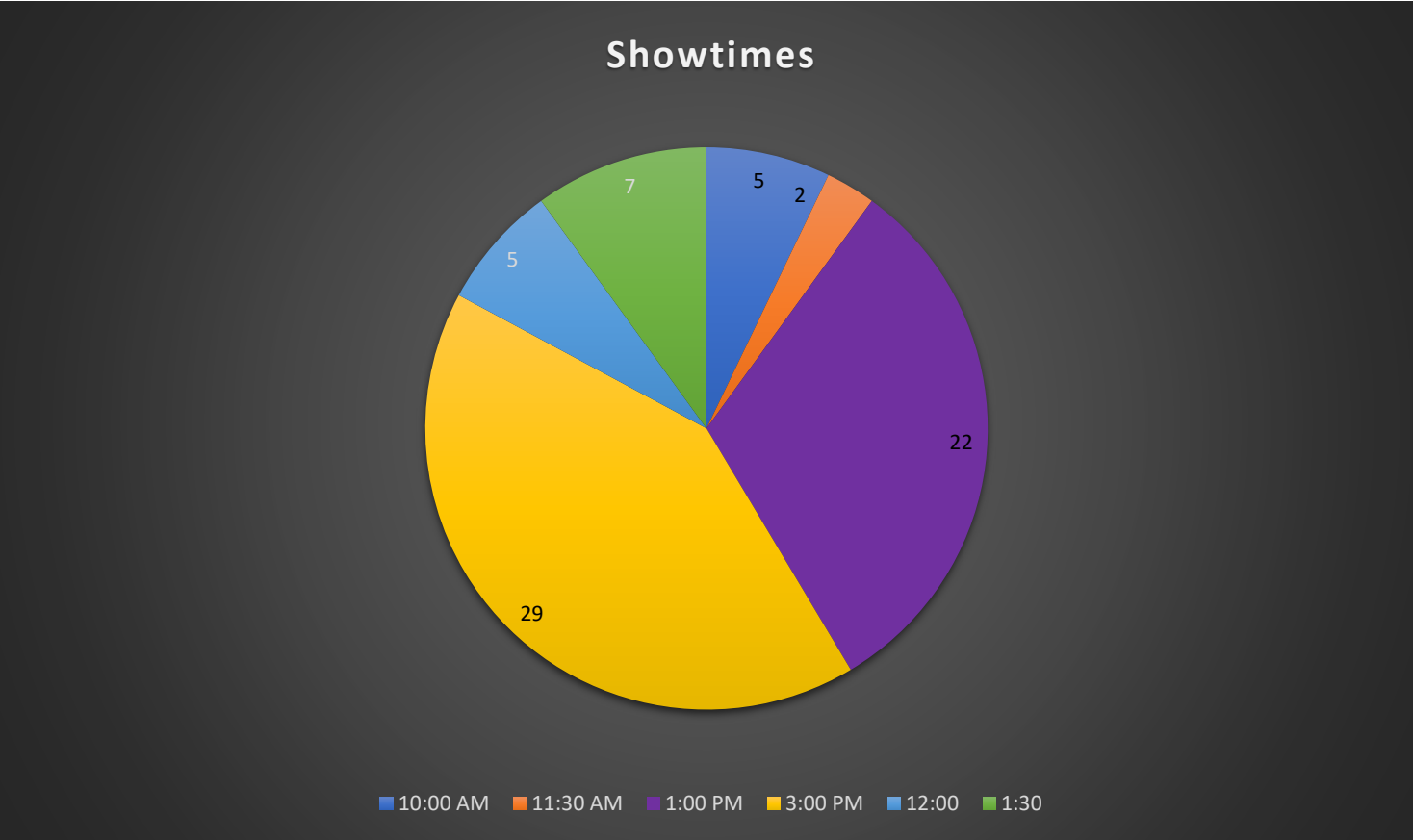
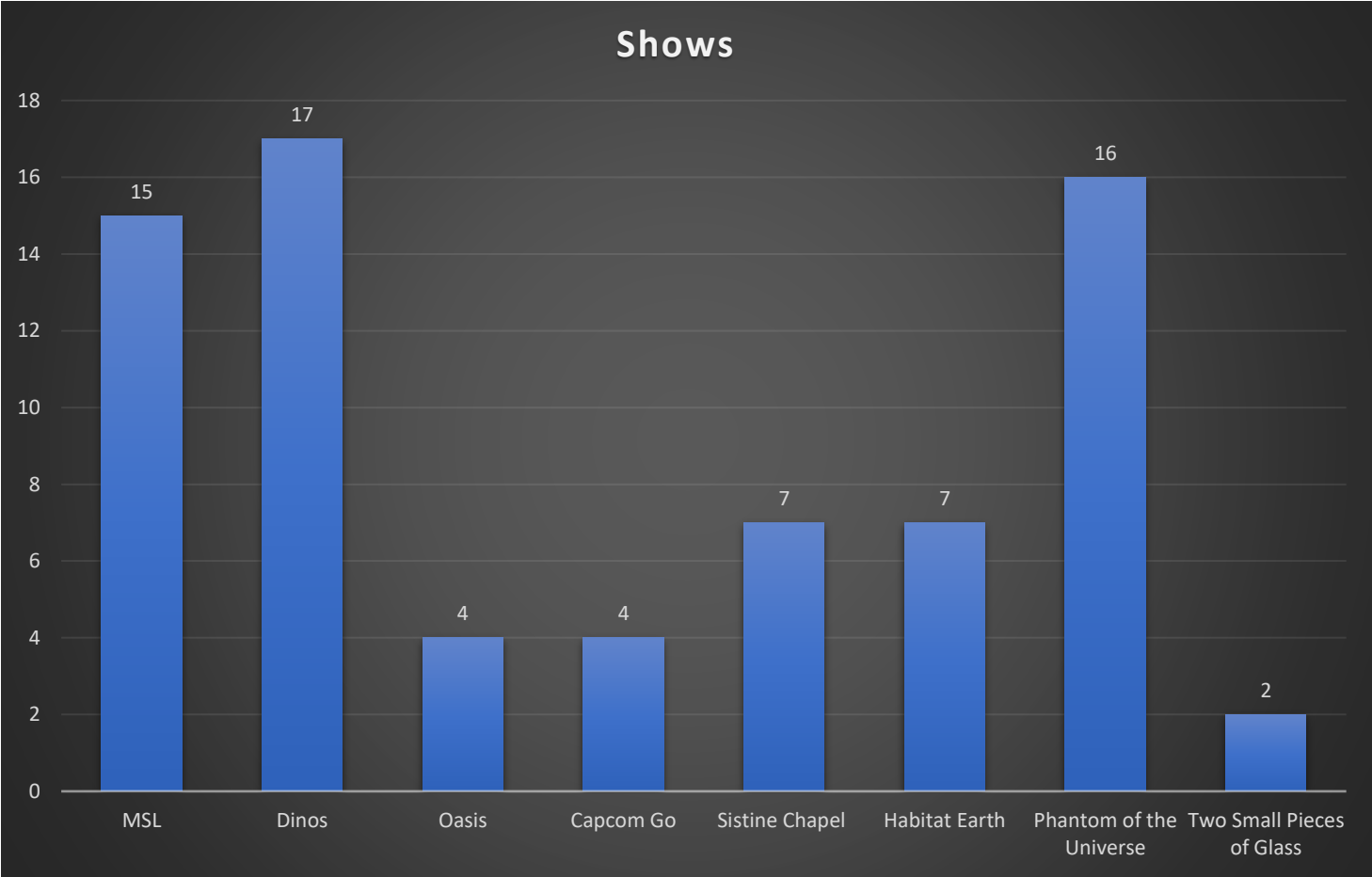
February 2021

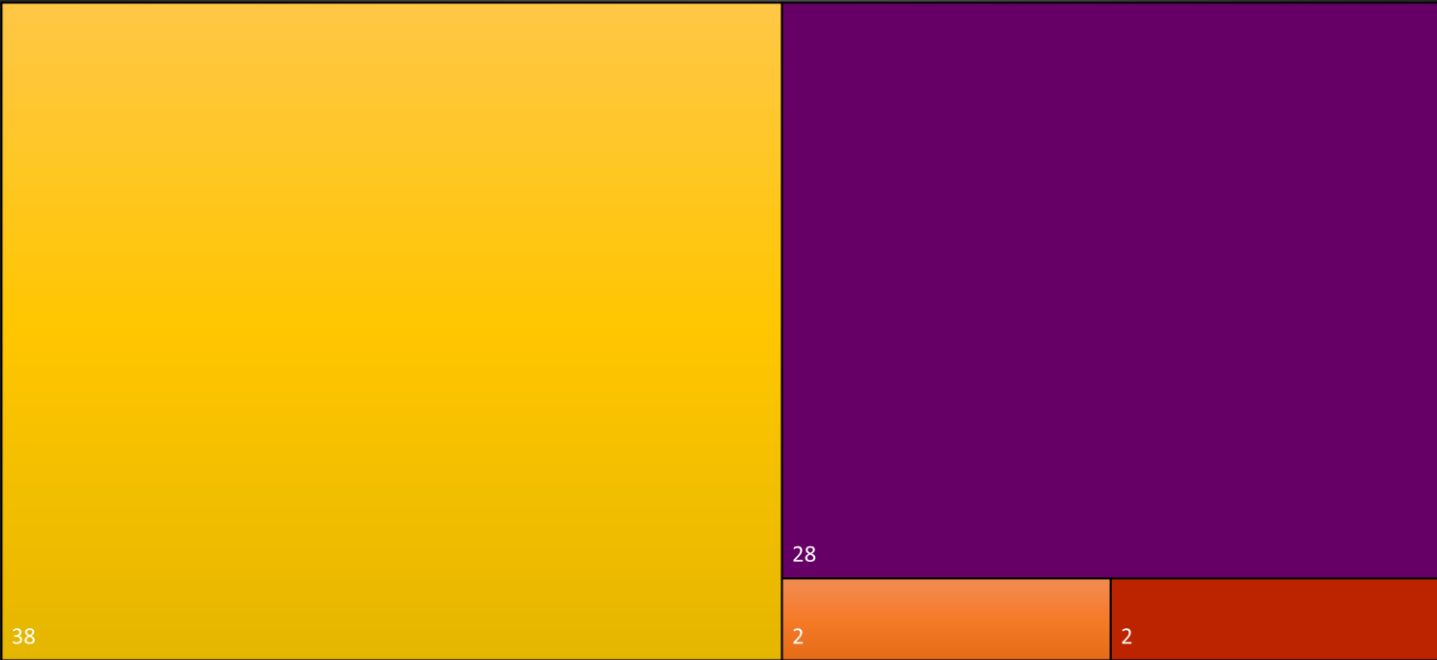

While we did not expect 100 people to show up, it was a solid turnout for a Thursday afternoon. We were leftover with plenty of supplies in the education kits too, so the demonstrations we did can be brought back out in the future.

The reduced times for the planetarium shows have not caused any issues as far as I know. If anything, shows during the weekdays have seen so little attendance, that it almost makes me think to just cut them out next year over the winter. Since spring is around the corner though, there is little point in changing the schedule drastically again, as tourists will be returning soon enough.

Total attendance for February was 70 in total, a very slow month. We only had 2 shows during the week, one on Thursday and one on Friday, everything else was on Saturday/ Sunday. This month I have added in Sunday's show times, since a large proportion of the attendance happened on Sunday. You might also notice that the total count for specific show is at 72 instead of 70, and this is due to Amanda being unable to present the Sistine Chapel initially, which allowed the guests to see two shows back-to-back.
