DNEM History Exhibit Update

Working with Katie Wolf over the past month, a second appeal letter was drafted for local businesses who have not yet contributed to the project. To date, over 30 appeal letters have been mailed out totaling \$270,000 in solicitation for donations.

Lenny Avery from Target Alpena is proposing the Besser Museum pursue a federal rural development loan. Lenny will explain the program to the Board on Tuesday, February 20th. There is also a \$50,000 grant opportunity through a rural development program that we will look into to. Katie Wolf and I will research more grant opportunities.
