The Collections Committee recommends the Besser Museum Board of Trustees accept the items listed below into the museum's Permanent Collection:

1. Artwork by local artist, Kati Meek. Handwoven image in linen and ramie, titled "Local Rock Group".
2. Photographs taken by Milo Burston ca. 1950. The photos include scenes from train derailment, "The Owl" building collapse, and the US-23 Greyhound Bus Crash.
3. One log cabin quilt top made by local resident Ann Whitten Paxton, ca. 1900.
4. One painting by local artist, Paul Domke Sr., titled "The Wartberg".
5. Desert Storm military uniform including two tops and five bottoms. The items belonged to local veteran, Mike Witt.
6. Two matchbooks from the Thunder Bay Mfg. Corp.
7. One Ossineke Hardware ashtray.
8. Five glass "Auto Fire" stops with holders.
9. Mid-century Girl Scout uniforms including skirts, tops, and hats. 12 items total.
10. Two copies of "Big Waters Girl Scout Council 1912-1972".
11. Two woolen swimsuits, ca. 1920s.
12. One glass eye that belonged to local resident Al Dammrose.
