

Annual Report

Katherine V - From June 17, 2020 to June 15, 2021

Total hours spent, 463 hours.

Projects accomplished

1. Deck built for the net reel between the Katherine V and the engine shed for demonstrations on net repair.
2. Made two more mannequins bringing total to 9 on display showing work done by commercial fishermen.
3. Helped Matt landscape around the Katherine V after putting cement barriers around the building.
4. Hauled gravel for new handicap walkway.

On August 18, 2020, started working on the Chinook by removing the cover. Started scraping and painting and got the slab ready to place the cradles.

On September 23rd, moved the Chinook to her final display area behind the Katherine. Finished painting, putting up her rigging.

On October 21st, started to enclose the aft deck from the pilot house to stern. Completed enclosing her November 5th.

Closed up the Katherine V on October 29, 2020.

Opened up the Katherine V on May 20, 2021.

Started building the handicap walkway on June 2 and work is still in progress.
